- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 391, Transportation Code,
- 5 is amended by adding Section 391.256 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 391.256. SCENIC BYWAYS PROGRAM. (a) The department
- 7 shall plan, design, and establish a program for designating
- 8 highways as State Scenic Byways.
- 9 (b) The program must include a process by which the
- 10 department:
- 11 (1) receives proposals from political subdivisions or
- 12 other community groups approved by the department for funding
- 13 projects in accordance with 23 U.S.C. Section 162;
- (2) applies for grants under 23 U.S.C. Section 162 for
- 15 the projects; and
- 16 (3) allows an applicant who consents to pay for the
- 17 costs of the projects that are not covered by grants made under 23
- 18 U.S.C. Section 162.
- (c) A highway must be designated as a State Scenic Byway
- 20 under the program established by this section before the department
- 21 applies for a grant under Subsection (b)(2) for a project related to
- 22 <u>the highway.</u>
- 23 (d) The department may use money from the state highway fund
- 24 for a project that receives a grant made under 23 U.S.C. Section 162

- 1 only for the purpose of satisfying matching funds requirements for
- 2 the grant.
- 3 (e) The department may only designate a highway described by
- 4 Section 391.252 as a State Scenic Byway.
- 5 (f) The commission by rule shall prohibit outdoor
- 6 advertising in a manner consistent with 23 U.S.C. Section 131(s) on
- 7 <u>a State Scenic Byway designated under this section.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2021, the Texas
- 9 Department of Transportation shall establish the program required
- 10 by Section 391.256, Transportation Code, as added by this Act, and
- 11 the Texas Transportation Commission shall adopt rules as necessary
- 12 to implement that section.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
