14	(2) the proposed use of water unreasonably affects:
15	(A) existing groundwater and surface water
16	resources <u>;</u> [ <del>or</del> ]
17	(B) existing permit holders; or
18	(C) wells that are exempt from the requirement to
19	obtain a permit under this chapter or district rules;
20	(3) the proposed use of water is dedicated to any
21	<pre>beneficial use;</pre>
22	(4) the proposed use of water is consistent with the
23	district's approved management plan;
24	(5) if the well will be located in the Hill Country

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1 Priority Groundwater Management Area, the proposed use of water 2 from the well is wholly or partly to provide water to a pond, lake, 3 or reservoir to enhance the appearance of the landscape;

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4 (6) the applicant has agreed to avoid waste and 5 achieve water conservation; and

6 (7) the applicant has agreed that reasonable diligence 7 will be used to protect groundwater quality and that the applicant 8 will follow well plugging guidelines at the time of well closure.

9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
