A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to measures to support or enhance graduate medical 3 education for the practice of podiatric medicine in this state. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 58A.001(5), Education Code, is amended 5 to read as follows: 6 (5) "Graduate medical education program" means: 7 (A) a nationally accredited post-doctor 8 of medicine (M.D.) or post-doctor of osteopathic medicine (D.O.) 9 program that prepares physicians for the independent practice of 10 11 medicine in a specific specialty area; and 12 (B) a nationally accredited post-doctor of 13 podiatric medicine (D.P.M.) program that prepares podiatrists for 14 independent practice in the specialty area of podiatry. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
