A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the expiration and extension of certain public health
 3 orders issued by a health authority.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 121, Health and Safety
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 121.026 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 121.026. EXPIRATION AND EXTENSION OF CERTAIN PUBLIC
- 8 HEALTH ORDERS ISSUED BY HEALTH AUTHORITY. (a) This section applies
- 9 only to a public health order imposed on more than one individual,
- 10 <u>animal</u>, place, or object.

- 11 (b) A public health order issued by a health authority under
- 12 this chapter or other law expires on the eighth day following the
- 13 date the order is issued unless, before the eighth day, the
- 14 governing body of a municipality or the commissioners court of a
- 15 county that appointed the health authority by majority vote extends
- 16 the order for a longer period.
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 121.026, Health and Safety Code, as
- 18 added by this Act, applies only to a public health order issued by a
- 19 health authority on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 20 public health order issued by a health authority before the
- 21 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the
- 22 public health order was issued, and the former law is continued in
- 23 effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
