10	(1) with a population of less than 55,000; and
11	(2) for which a county equalization tax was adopted
12	under former Chapter 18 of this code, as that chapter existed on May
13	1, 1995, and continues in effect under Section 11.301.
14	Sec. 45.352. ELECTION TO REVOKE COUNTY EQUALIZATION TAX.
15	The commissioners court of a county to which this subchapter
16	applies may order an election on the question of revoking the county
17	equalization tax, in accordance with former Section 18.11 of this
18	code and other applicable provisions of former Chapter 18, as that
19	chapter existed on May 1, 1995, that continues in effect under
20	<u>Section 11.301.</u>
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
22	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
23	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
