4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- 5 SECTION 1. Section 11.27, Tax Code, is amended by amending 6 Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A person is entitled to an exemption from taxation of
- 8 the amount of appraised value of <u>real</u> [his] property <u>owned by the</u>
- 9 person that arises from the installation or construction on the
- 10 property of a solar or wind-powered energy device that is primarily
- 11 for production and distribution of energy for on-site use.
- 12 (a-1) A person is entitled to an exemption from taxation of
- 13 the appraised value of a solar or wind-powered energy device owned
- 14 by the person that is installed or constructed on real property and
- 15 is primarily for production and distribution of energy for on-site
- 16 use regardless of whether the person owns the real property on which
- 17 the device is installed or constructed.

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- SECTION 2. The amendment made by this Act is a clarification
- 19 of existing law and does not imply that existing law may be
- 20 construed as inconsistent with the law as amended by this Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

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1 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
