| 4 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: |
| 5 | SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 121, Health and Safety |
| 6 | Code, is amended by adding Section 121.0055 to read as follows: |
| 7 | Sec. 121.0055. SANITARIAN RECRUITMENT AND RETENTION |
| 8 | PROGRAM IN BORDER COUNTIES. (a) This section applies only to a |
| 9 | local health unit, local health department, or public health |
| 10 | district that is: |
| 11 | (1) located in a county adjacent to the international |
| 12 | border with Mexico; and |
| 13 | (2) affiliated with the department under Section |
| 14 | 121.005. |
| 15 | (b) To the extent money is available, the department shall |
| 16 | establish a program to: |
| 17 | (1) provide grants to local health units, local health |
| 18 | departments, and public health districts to improve recruitment and |
| 19 | retention of sanitarians registered under Chapter 1953, |
| 20 | Occupations Code; and |
| 21 | (2) expand opportunities for training and |
| 22 | registration of sanitarians to improve disease response and prevent |
| 23 | foodborne, waterborne, vector-borne, and zoonotic diseases. |
| 24 | (c) The department shall administer the grant program in |

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- 1 coordination with local health units, local health departments,
- 2 public health districts, and appropriate state agencies, federal
- 3 agencies, nonprofit organizations, public and private hospitals,
- 4 institutions of higher education, and other private entities.
- 5 (d) The department may award a grant under Subsection (b)
- 6 only in accordance with a contract between the department and the
- 7 grant recipient. The contract must include provisions affording
- 8 the department sufficient control to ensure the public purpose of
- 9 improved public health is accomplished and this state receives a
- 10 return benefit from the grant recipient.
- 11 (e) The department may solicit and accept gifts, grants, and
- 12 donations to operate the grant program. The department shall
- 13 coordinate with appropriate state agencies, federal agencies,
- 14 nonprofit organizations, public and private hospitals,
- 15 institutions of higher education, and other private entities in
- 16 <u>identifying and soliciting funding to implement this section.</u>
- 17 SECTION 2. The Department of State Health Services is
- 18 required to implement a provision of this Act only if the
- 19 legislature appropriates money specifically for that purpose. If
- 20 the legislature does not appropriate money specifically for that
- 21 purpose, the department may, but is not required to, implement a
- 22 provision of this Act using other appropriations available for that
- 23 purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
