- 5 SECTION 1. Section 105.06(a), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 6 amended by amending Subdivision (2) and adding Subdivision (3) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (2) "Public place" means a place to which the public or
- 9 a substantial group of the public has access and includes:
- 10 (A) a licensed or permitted premises; and
- 11 (B) a street, highway, or park or a common area of
- 12 <u>a school, hospital, apartment, office building, transportation</u>
- 13 <u>facility</u>, shop, restaurant, or nightclub.
- 14 (3) "Standard hours area" means an area which is not an
- 15 extended hours area.
- SECTION 2. Sections 105.06(a-1), (b), and (c), Alcoholic
- 17 Beverage Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 18 (a-1) For the purposes of this section, the prohibition on
- 19 the consumption of alcoholic beverages during certain hours in a
- 20 public place applies to all public places regardless of whether the
- 21 <u>public place is</u> a licensed or permitted premises [is a public
- 22 place].
- 23 (b) In a standard hours area, a person commits an offense if
- 24 the person [he] consumes or possesses with intent to consume an

- 2 1:15 a.m. and 12 noon or on any other day between 12:15 a.m. and 7
- 3 a.m.
- 4 (c) In an extended hours area, a person commits an offense
- 5 if the person [he] consumes or possesses with intent to consume an
- 6 alcoholic beverage in a public place at any time on Sunday between
- 7 2:15 a.m. and 12 noon and on any other day between 2:15 a.m. and 7
- 8 a.m.
- 9 SECTION 3. (a) Section 105.06, Alcoholic Beverage Code, as
- 10 amended by this Act, applies only to an offense committed on or
- 11 after the effective date of this Act. For the purposes of this
- 12 section, an offense is committed before the effective date of this
- 13 Act if any element of the offense occurs before that date.
- 14 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
- 15 Act is covered by the law in effect immediately before the effective
- 16 date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 17 purpose.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
