(e) If a retiring member or retiree under this section presents evidence satisfactory to the retirement system that the person's occupational disability makes the person incapable of

substantial gainful activity solely because of the disability and is considered a total disability under federal social security law,

19 SECTION 2. (a) Subject to Subsection (b) of this section,

20 the Employees Retirement System of Texas shall recompute an annuity

21 that first became payable before September 1, 2021, as though

22 Section 814.207(e), Government Code, as amended by this Act, was in

23 effect on the date the increased annuity first became payable.

24 (b) The first payment of an annuity recomputed under

- 2 occurring on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. The Employees Retirement System of Texas is
- 4 required to implement a provision of this Act only if the
- 5 legislature appropriates money specifically for that purpose. If
- 6 the legislature does not appropriate money specifically for that
- 7 purpose, the Employees Retirement System of Texas may, but is not
- 8 required to, implement a provision of this Act using other
- 9 appropriations available for that purpose.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
