2 relating to disability retirement benefits for certain peace
3 officers under the Employees Retirement System of Texas.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 814.207(e), Government Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:

7 If a retiring member or retiree under this section (e) 8 presents evidence satisfactory to the retirement system that the person's occupational disability makes the person incapable of 9 10 substantial gainful activity solely because of the disability and is considered a total disability under federal social security law, 11 the retirement system shall, notwithstanding Section 811.006, 12 increase the person's occupational disability retirement annuity 13 to a monthly amount computed based on the maximum salary authorized 14 15 under the position classification salary schedule prescribed by the General Appropriations Act, as adjusted from time to time, 16 17 applicable to the position from which the person retired [100 percent of the officer's average monthly compensation]. 18

19 SECTION 2. (a) Subject to Subsection (b) of this section, 20 the Employees Retirement System of Texas shall recompute an annuity 21 that first became payable before September 1, 2021, as though 22 Section 814.207(e), Government Code, as amended by this Act, was in 23 effect on the date the increased annuity first became payable.

24 (b) The first payment of an annuity recomputed under

Subsection (a) of this section is payable on the first payment date
 occurring on or after the effective date of this Act.

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
