A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-21 relating to parental approval for a student's participation in 1-22 1-23 human sexuality instruction in public schools.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 28.004, Education Code, is amended by amending Subsections (i) and (i-1) and adding Subsection (i-2) to 1-24 1-25 1-26 read as follows:

1-27 1-28 Before each school year, a school district shall provide (i) written notice to a parent of each student enrolled in the district 1-29 of the board of trustees' decision regarding whether the district 1-30 will provide human sexuality instruction to district students. If 1-31

instruction will be provided, the notice must include: (1) a summary of the basic content of the district's human sexuality instruction to be provided to the student, 1-32 1-33 including a statement informing the parent of the instructional 1-34 1-35 requirements under state law; 1-36 (2)

a statement of the parent's right to:

1-37 (A) review curriculum materials as provided by 1-38 Subsection (j); and

refuse consent for [remove] the student to 1-39 (B) receive all or [from] any part of the district's human sexuality 1-40 instruction without subjecting the student to any disciplinary 1-41 1-42 action, academic penalty, or other sanction imposed by the district 1-43 or the student's school; and

1 - 44(3) information describing the opportunities for 1-45 parental involvement in the development of the curriculum to be used in human sexuality instruction, including information regarding the local school health advisory council established 1-46 1-47 1-48 under Subsection (a).

1-49 (i-1) A parent may use the grievance procedure adopted under 1-50 Section 26.011 concerning a complaint of a violation of Subsection (i) <u>or (i-2)</u>. 1-51

(i-2) Before a student may be provided with human sexuality instruction, a school district must obtain the written consent of the student's parent. A request for written consent under this 1-52 1-53 1-54 1-55 subsection: 1-56

(1) may not be included with any other notification or request for written consent provided to the parent, other than the notice provided under Subsection (i); and 1-57 1-58

(2) must be provided to the parent not later than the 1-59 14th day before the date on which the human sexuality instruction 1-60 1-61 begins.
