## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the disclosure of certain information regarding course

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 51.452, Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 51.452. DISSEMINATION OF COURSE SCHEDULE AND LIST OF
- 8 REQUIRED AND RECOMMENDED COURSE MATERIALS [TEXTBOOKS]. (a) In
- 9 this section:
- 10 (1) "Course material" means a textbook, supplemental
- 11 material, or open educational resource.
- 12 (2) "Institution of higher education,"
- 13 <u>notwithstanding Section 51.451</u>, has the meaning assigned by Section
- 14 61.003.
- 15 (b) Not later than the 30th day before the first day that
- 16 classes are conducted for each semester or academic term, each
- 17 [Each] institution of higher education shall:
- 18 (1) [for each semester or academic term, compile a
- 19 course schedule indicating each course offered by the institution
- 20 for the semester or term to postsecondary students;
- 21 (2) with respect to each course, include with the
- 22 schedule a list of the required and recommended course materials
- 23 [textbooks] that specifies, to the extent practicable, the
- 24 following information for each course material, as applicable

- 15 practicable after the institution has compiled the schedule and
- 16 list but not later than the 30th day before the first day that
- 17 classes are conducted for the semester or other academic term for
- 18 which the schedule and list are compiled].
- 19 (g) [<del>(d)</del>] If an institution of higher education or a college
- 20 bookstore publishes a course materials [textbook] list with a
- 21 course schedule on an Internet website that provides a search
- 22 function, the institution or bookstore must:
- 23 (1) ensure that the search function permits a search
- 24 based on whether a course or section of a course requires or
- 25 recommends only open educational resources; or
- 26 (2) provide a searchable list of courses and sections
- 27 of courses that require or recommend only open educational

- 1 resources.
- 2 (h) If an institution of higher education designates in the
- 3 <u>institution's course schedule certain courses or sections of</u>
- 4 courses as having low course material costs or a similar
- 5 designation, the institution shall, in a prominent location in the
- 6 schedule, state or provide an Internet website link to the criteria
- 7 for that designation.
- 8 <u>(i)</u> This section may not be construed to affect any
- 9 authority granted to a faculty member by an institution of higher
- 10 education to select course materials for courses taught by the
- 11 <u>faculty member.</u>
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 51.452, Education Code, as amended by
- 13 this Act, applies beginning with the 2022 fall semester.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
