1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to notice regarding the availability to public school
 1-22 students of college credit and work-based education programs and
 1-23 subsidies for fees paid to take certain advanced placement tests.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 28.010, Education Code,
 1-26 is amended to read as follows:

1-27 Sec. 28.010. NOTIFICATION REGARDING COLLEGE CREDIT AND
 1-28 WORK-BASED EDUCATION PROGRAMS.

1-29 SECTION 2. Section 28.010(a), Education Code, is amended to
 1-30 read as follows:

1-31 (a) Each school year, a school district shall notify the
 1-32 parent of each district student enrolled in grade nine or above of:

1-33 (1) the availability of:

1-34 (A) programs in the district under which a
 1-35 student may earn college credit, including advanced placement
 1-36 programs, dual credit programs, joint high school and college
 1-37 credit programs, and international baccalaureate programs;

1-38 (B) career and technology education programs or
 1-39 other work-based education programs in the district, including any
 1-40 internship, externship, or apprenticeship programs or a P-TECH
 1-41 program under Subchapter N, Chapter 29; and

1-42 (C) subsidies based on financial need available
 1-43 for fees paid to take college advanced placement tests or
 1-44 international baccalaureate examinations under Section 28.054; and

1-45 (2) the qualifications for enrolling in programs
 1-46 described by Subdivision (1)(A) or (B).

1-47 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2021-2022
 1-48 school year.

1-49 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-50 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-51 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-52 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-53 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
