1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the composition of the board of directors of the Fort
 1-22 Bend Subsidence District, including a director's qualifications
 1-23 and term.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Section 8834.051, Special District Local Laws
 1-26 Code, is amended by amending Subsections (a), (e), (f), and (i) to
 1-27 read as follows:

1-28 (a) The district is governed by a board of 17 [~~15~~] directors
 1-29 appointed as provided by this section.

1-30 (e) The mayor of each of the following municipalities shall
 1-31 appoint a director from the mayor's respective municipality:

- 1-32 (1) Houston;
- 1-33 (2) Missouri City;
- 1-34 (3) Stafford;
- 1-35 (4) Sugar Land;
- 1-36 (5) Rosenberg; [~~and~~]
- 1-37 (6) Richmond; and
- 1-38 (7) Fulshear.

1-39 (f) The Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County shall
 1-40 appoint:

- 1-41 (1) two directors who represent agricultural
- 1-42 interests and live in an unincorporated area;
- 1-43 (2) two directors who represent industrial interests;
- 1-44 [~~and~~]
- 1-45 (3) two directors who represent business interests;
- 1-46 and
- 1-47 (4) one director who represents the district at large.

1-48 (i) The directors shall serve staggered terms as follows:

1-49 (1) five members appointed under Subsection (e) and
 1-50 four members appointed under Subsection (f) shall serve terms
 1-51 expiring on January 1 of odd-numbered years; and

1-52 (2) two members [~~one member~~] appointed under
 1-53 Subsection (e), three [~~two~~] members appointed under Subsection (f),
 1-54 one member appointed under Subsection (g), and two members
 1-55 appointed under Subsection (h) shall serve terms expiring on
 1-56 January 1 of even-numbered years.

1-57 SECTION 2. Not later than November 1, 2021, the mayor of the
 1-58 City of Fulshear and the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County
 1-59 shall appoint members of the board of directors of the Fort Bend
 1-60 Subsidence District as provided by Section 8834.051, Special

2-1 District Local Laws Code, as amended by this Act.

2-2 SECTION 3. The Fort Bend Subsidence District retains all
2-3 the rights, powers, privileges, authority, duties, and functions
2-4 that it had before the effective date of this Act.

2-5 SECTION 4. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
2-6 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
2-7 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
2-8 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
2-9 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
2-10 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
2-11 Government Code.

2-12 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
2-13 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
2-14 Environmental Quality.

2-15 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
2-16 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
2-17 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
2-18 representatives within the required time.

2-19 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
2-20 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
2-21 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
2-22 and accomplished.

2-23 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
2-24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
2-25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2-26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
2-27 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
