S.B. No. 1155

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to the eligibility of certain events for funding under the
Major Events Reimbursement Program.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 478.0001(3), Government Code, as
effective April 1, 2021, is amended to read as follows:

(3) "Event" means any of the following and includes
any activity related to or associated with the following:

(A) the Academy of Country Music Awards;

(B) the Amateur Athletic Union Junior Olympic
Games;

(C) the Breeders' Cup World Championships;

(D) a game of the College Football Playoff or its
successor;

(E) an Elite Rodeo Association World
Championship;

(F) a Formula One automobile race;

(G) the largest event held each year at a sports
entertainment venue in this state with a permanent seating
capacity, including grandstand and premium seating, of at least
125,000 on September 1, 2021;

(H) the Major League Baseball All-Star Game;

(I) the Major League Soccer All-Star Game or the
Major League Soccer Cup;

- 2 (K) the Moto Grand Prix of the United States;
- 3 (L) the National Association for Stock Car Auto
4 Racing (NASCAR):
- 5 (i) All-Star Race; [~~or~~]
- 6 (ii) season-ending Championship Race; or
- 7 (iii) Texas Grand Prix race;
- 8 (M) the National Basketball Association All-Star
9 Game;
- 10 (N) a National Collegiate Athletic Association
11 Final Four tournament game;
- 12 (O) the National Collegiate Athletic Association
13 men's or women's lacrosse championships;
- 14 (P) a national collegiate championship of an
15 amateur sport sanctioned by the national governing body of the
16 sport that is recognized by the United States Olympic Committee;
- 17 (Q) the National Cutting Horse Association
18 Triple Crown;
- 19 (R) the National Hockey League All-Star Game;
- 20 (S) a national political convention of the
21 Republican National Committee or the Democratic National
22 Committee;
- 23 (T) an Olympic activity, including a Junior or
24 Senior activity, training program, or feeder program sanctioned by
25 the United States Olympic Committee's Community Olympic
26 Development Program;
- 27 (U) a presidential general election debate;

1 (V) the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association
2 National Finals Rodeo;

3 (W) a Super Bowl;

4 (X) the United States Open Championship;

5 (Y) a World Cup soccer game or the World Cup
6 soccer tournament;

7 (Z) the World Games; or

8 (AA) the X Games.

9 SECTION 2. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails
10 over another Act of the 87th Legislature, Regular Session, 2021,
11 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted
12 codes.

13 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
