1-19 relating to the eligibility of certain events for funding under the
 1-20 Major Events Reimbursement Program.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 478.0001(3), Government Code, as
 1-23 effective April 1, 2021, is amended to read as follows:

1-24 (3) "Event" means any of the following and includes
 1-25 any activity related to or associated with the following:

1-26 (A) the Academy of Country Music Awards;
 1-27 (B) the Amateur Athletic Union Junior Olympic
 1-28 Games;

1-29 (C) the Breeders' Cup World Championships;
 1-30 (D) a game of the College Football Playoff or its
 1-31 successor;

1-32 (E) an Elite Rodeo Association World
 1-33 Championship;

1-34 (F) a Formula One automobile race;
 1-35 (G) the largest event held each year at a sports
 1-36 entertainment venue in this state with a permanent seating
 1-37 capacity, including grandstand and premium seating, of at least
 1-38 125,000 on September 1, 2021;

1-39 (H) the Major League Baseball All-Star Game;

1-40 (I) the Major League Soccer All-Star Game or the
 1-41 Major League Soccer Cup;

1-42 (J) a mixed martial arts championship;

1-43 (K) the Moto Grand Prix of the United States;

1-44 (L) the National Association for Stock Car Auto
 1-45 Racing (NASCAR):

1-46 (i) All-Star Race; ~~or~~

1-47 (ii) season-ending Championship Race; or

1-48 (iii) Texas Grand Prix race;

1-49 (M) the National Basketball Association All-Star
 1-50 Game;

1-51 (N) a National Collegiate Athletic Association

 2-8 (V) the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association
 2-9 National Finals Rodeo;
 2-10 (W) a Super Bowl;
 2-11 (X) the United States Open Championship;
 2-12 (Y) a World Cup soccer game or the World Cup
 2-13 soccer tournament;
 2-14 (Z) the World Games; or
 2-15 (AA) the X Games.

2-16 SECTION 2. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails
 2-17 over another Act of the 87th Legislature, Regular Session, 2021,
 2-18 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted
 2-19 codes.

2-20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
