A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-25 relating to the contracting authority of the Health and Human 1-26 Services Commission for the volunteer advocate for children 1-27 1-28 program.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-29 SECTION 1. Section 264.603(a), Family Code, is amended to 1-30 read as follows:

(a) The commission shall contract with one statewide organization that is exempt from federal income taxation under 1-31 1-32 1-33 Section 501(a), Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as an organization described by Section 501(c)(3) of that code [and designated as a 1-34 supporting organization under Section 509(a)(3) of that code,] and 1-35 1-36 that is composed of individuals or groups of individuals who have 1-37 expertise in the dynamics of child abuse and neglect and experience in operating volunteer advocate programs to provide training, technical assistance, and evaluation services for the benefit of 1-38 1-39 1-40 local volunteer advocate programs. The contract shall:

1-41 (1)include measurable goals and objectives relating 1-42 to the number of: 1-43

volunteer advocates in the program; and (A)

1 - 44(B) children receiving services from the 1-45 program; and

1-46 (2)follow practices designed to ensure compliance 1-47 with standards referenced in the contract.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-48 1-49 a vote of two-thirds of all members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-50 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-51 1-52 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
