1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1-20 AN ACT

relating to the authority of a county to require a person to obtain a building permit from the county for certain portable structures.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 233, Local Government Code, is amended by adding Section 233.902 to read as follows:

Sec. 233.902. PORTABLE STRUCTURE FOR PERIODIC SALE OF RETAIL GOODS. (a) Notwithstanding any other law and except as provided by Subsection (b), a county may not require a building permit to construct, improve, or occupy a structure used for not more than 60 days in a calendar year for the retail sale of goods if the structure is:

(1) portable; and

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(2) smaller than 500 square feet.

This section does not prevent a county from enforcing a fire code adopted by the county or inspecting a structure for a fire or life safety hazard as authorized by other law.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-39 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-41 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
