## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the procedure for donating juror reimbursements.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Sections 61.003(a) and (e), Government Code, are 5 amended to read as follows:

- 6 (a) After jury service is concluded, each [Each] person who
  7 reported [reports] for jury service shall be personally provided a
  8 form letter that when signed by the person directs the county
  9 treasurer to donate all, or a specific amount designated by the
  10 person, of the person's daily reimbursement under this chapter to:
- (1) the compensation to victims of crime fund established under Subchapter J, Chapter 56B, Code of Criminal Procedure;
- 14 (2) the child welfare, child protective services, or 15 child services board of the county appointed under Section 264.005, 16 Family Code, that serves abused and neglected children;
- 17 (3) any program selected by the commissioners court 18 that is operated by a public or private nonprofit organization and 19 that provides shelter and services to victims of family violence;
- (4) any other program approved by the commissioners court of the county, including a program established under Article 56A.205, Code of Criminal Procedure, that offers psychological counseling in criminal cases involving graphic evidence or testimony; or

- 1 (5) a veterans <u>treatment</u> court program established by 2 the commissioners court as provided by Chapter 124.
- 3 (e) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), a county that has
- 4 adopted a system or method of payment authorized by Section
- 5 113.048, Local Government Code, may provide a person who reported
- 6 [reports] for jury service in the county an opportunity to donate
- 7 all, or a specific part designated by the juror, of the juror's
- 8 daily reimbursement by completing a self-executing application on a
- 9 form prescribed by the commissioners court that is provided after
- 10 jury service is concluded.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a person summoned to
- 12 appear for jury service who is required to appear on or after the
- 13 effective date of this Act. A person summoned to appear for jury
- 14 service who is required to appear before the effective date of this
- 15 Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before the
- 16 effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in
- 17 effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
