6	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 32, Human Resources Code,

- 7 is amended by adding Section 32.02472 to read as follows:
- Sec. 32.02472. EXPANDED ELIGIBILITY FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE 8
- UNDER PATIENT PROTECTION AND AFFORDABLE CARE ACT. 9 (a)
- Notwithstanding any other law, the commission shall provide medical 10
- 11 assistance to all persons who apply for that assistance and for whom
- 12 federal matching money is available under the Patient Protection
- and Affordable Care Act (Pub. L. No. 111-148), as amended by the 13
- 14 Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010 (Pub. L. No.
- 111-152), to provide that assistance. 15
- 16 (b) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules regarding
- the provision of medical assistance as required by this section. 17
- SECTION 2. Section 32.02472, Human Resources Code, as added 18
- by this Act, applies only to an initial determination or 19
- 20 recertification of eligibility of a person for medical assistance
- 21 under Chapter 32, Human Resources Code, made on or after the date
- the section is implemented, regardless of the date the person 22
- 23 applied for that assistance.
- 24 SECTION 3. As soon as possible after the effective date of

- 1 this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 2 Services Commission shall take all necessary actions to expand
- 3 eligibility for medical assistance under Chapter 32, Human
- 4 Resources Code, in accordance with Section 32.02472, Human
- 5 Resources Code, as added by this Act, including notifying
- 6 appropriate federal agencies of that expanded eligibility.
- 7 SECTION 4. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 8 a state agency determines that any other waiver or authorization
- 9 from a federal agency is necessary for implementation of that
- 10 provision, the agency affected by the provision shall request the
- 11 waiver or authorization and may delay implementing that provision
- 12 until the waiver or authorization is granted.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
