4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 775, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 775.0222 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 775.0222. EXCEPTION TO MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY TO REMOVE
8	TERRITORY. (a) A district may object to the removal of territory
9	under Section 775.022 if the removal would have the effect of:
10	(1) reducing the level of emergency services provided
11	to the district territory inside or outside the annexed area; or
12	(2) reducing district revenue to a level that would:
13	(A) be insufficient to carry out the district's
14	purposes in territory outside the annexed area; or
15	(B) require the district to increase the tax
16	burden on territory outside the annexed area in order to maintain
17	current services and commitments.
18	(b) Notwithstanding Section 775.022, if a district objects
19	to the removal of territory under Subsection (a), the municipality
20	may not remove the annexed territory from the district.
21	(c) A district that objects to the removal of territory
22	under Subsection (a) shall continue providing services in the
23	territory.
24	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
