## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to prohibiting certain limitations on the operation of
- 3 businesses that hold a winery permit during a declared state of
- 4 disaster.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 418.012, Government Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 418.012. EXECUTIVE ORDERS. (a) Under this chapter,
- 9 the governor may issue executive orders, proclamations, and
- 10 regulations and amend or rescind them. Executive orders,
- 11 proclamations, and regulations have the force and effect of law.
- 12 (b) An executive order, proclamation, or regulation issued
- 13 by the governor under this chapter that restricts the operation of
- 14 or the hours of operation for a business that sells alcoholic
- 15 beverages may not include a business that holds a winery permit
- 16 issued by the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission under Chapter 16,
- 17 Alcoholic Beverage Code.
- SECTION 2. Section 418.012, Government Code, as amended by
- 19 this Act, applies only to a declaration of a state of disaster
- 20 issued or renewed on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 21 declaration issued before the effective date of this Act is
- 22 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
- 23 of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
