1-19 relating to substitutes for hydrofluorocarbon refrigerants
 1-20 applicable to commercial or residential buildings or construction.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Chapter 382, Health and Safety Code, is amended
 1-23 by adding Subchapter L to read as follows:

1-24 SUBCHAPTER L. REGULATION OF HYDROFLUOROCARBONS

1-25 Sec. 382.551. SUBSTITUTES FOR HYDROFLUOROCARBON
 1-26 REFRIGERANTS APPLICABLE TO COMMERCIAL OR RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS OR
 1-27 CONSTRUCTION. A building code or other requirement applicable to
 1-28 commercial or residential buildings or construction may not
 1-29 prohibit the use of a substitute refrigerant authorized pursuant to
 1-30 42 U.S.C. Section 7671k.

1-31 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2023.
