- 5 SECTION 1. Section 74.01, Alcoholic Beverage Code, as
- 6 effective September 1, 2021, is amended by amending Subsection (a)
- 7 and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (a) A holder of a brewpub license for a brewpub located in a
- 9 wet area, as that term is described by Section 251.71, may:
- 10 (1) brew, bottle, can, package, and label malt
- 11 beverages;
- 12 (2) sell or offer without charge, on the premises of
- 13 the brewpub, to ultimate consumers for consumption on or off those
- 14 premises, malt beverages produced by the holder, in or from a lawful
- 15 container, to the extent the sales or offers are allowed under the
- 16 holder's other permits or licenses; [and]
- 17 (3) sell food on the premises of the holder's
- 18 breweries; and
- 19 <u>(4) conduct samplings of malt beverages, including</u>
- 20 tastings, at a retailer's premises.
- 21 <u>(a-1)</u> An agent or employee of the holder of a brewpub
- 22 license may open, touch, or pour malt beverages, make a
- 23 presentation, or answer questions at a sampling event.
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
