4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 74.01, Alcoholic Beverage Code, as
6	effective September 1, 2021, is amended by amending Subsection (a)
7	and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
8	(a) A holder of a brewpub license for a brewpub located in a
9	wet area, as that term is described by Section 251.71, may:
10	(1) brew, bottle, can, package, and label malt
11	beverages;
12	(2) sell or offer without charge, on the premises of
13	the brewpub, to ultimate consumers for consumption on or off those
14	premises, malt beverages produced by the holder, in or from a lawful
15	container, to the extent the sales or offers are allowed under the
16	holder's other permits or licenses; [and]
17	(3) sell food on the premises of the holder's
18	breweries; and
19	(4) conduct samplings of malt beverages, including
20	tastings, at a retailer's premises.
21	(a-1) An agent or employee of the holder of a brewpub
22	license may open, touch, or pour malt beverages, make a
23	presentation, or answer questions at a sampling event.
24	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
