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1-36 1-37 1-38 relating to a requirement that a voting system use a paper record or produce a paper receipt for verification purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 129, Election Code, is amended by adding Section 129.003 to read as follows:

Sec. 129.003. PAPER AUDIT TRAIL REQUIRED. (a) In this section, "auditable voting system" means a voting system that:

(1) uses a paper record; or

(2) produces a paper receipt by which a voter can verify that the voter's ballot will be counted accurately.

(b) Except as otherwise provided by this section, a voting system used in an election must be an auditable voting system.

- (c) Except for a recount under Title 13, the electronic vote is the official record of the ballot. For a recount of ballots cast on a system involving direct recording electronic voting machines, the paper record or receipt copy is the official record of the vote cast.
- (d) A paper record generated by an auditable voting system may be used only for the purposes described by this section and may not be retained by the voter.
- 1-39 (e) This section does not apply to an election held before 1-40 March 1, 2024.
- 1-41 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
