1 regulate the taking and conservation of fish, oysters, shrimp,
2 crabs, turtles, terrapins, mussels, lobsters, and all other kinds
3 and forms of marine life, or sand, gravel, marl, mud shell, and all
4 other kinds of shell in accordance with the authority vested in it
5 by this code.

6 <u>(e) Any wild animal, including a fur-bearing animal, wild</u> 7 <u>bird, or wild fowl, described by Subsection (a) or fish or other</u> 8 <u>aquatic animal life described by Subsection (b) or (d) that is</u> 9 <u>possessed under a license or permit issued by the department</u> 10 <u>remains the property of the state.</u>
