A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to the terms and renewal of oyster certificates of 3 location.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 76.018(b) and (c), Parks and Wildlife
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The commission shall determine renewal procedures to
- 8 follow at the end of each lease term. The procedures:
- 9 <u>(1)</u> must include:
- (A) $\left[\frac{1}{1}\right]$ a determination that the lease renewal
- 11 will be based on the need for depuration of polluted oysters and
- 12 other considerations specified in the oyster management plan;
- 13 (B) [(2)] payment of a [\$200] fee <u>in an amount</u>
- 14 <u>set by the commission</u>, due on <u>execution</u> [<u>renewal</u>] of the lease; <u>and</u>
- (C) $[\frac{(3)}{3}]$ a condition providing that the current
- 16 leaseholder will be offered a first right of refusal at the cost of
- 17 the highest bid at a public auction [if the lease is renewed under
- 18 this chapter]; and

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- 19 (2) may include [(4)] any other conditions [for the]
- 20 lease renewal] that do not conflict with this chapter.
- 21 (c) The commission shall determine public auction
- 22 procedures for the issuance of a lease [that is not renewed by the
- 23 previous leaseholder under Subsection (b)].
- 24 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act to Section

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- 1 76.018, Parks and Wildlife Code, apply only to the lease of an
- 2 oyster certificate of location executed on or after the effective
- 3 date of this Act. A lease for an oyster certificate of location
- 4 executed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- 5 law in effect on the date the lease was executed, and the former law
- 6 is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
