18	(2) seek the approval of the United States Congress

- Sec. 793.003. INTERSTATE COMPACT PROVISIONS. The compact 20
- required by this chapter must provide for joint action among 21
- 22 compacting states on matters that include:
- (1) the operational control of this state's border 23
- 24 with Mexico by the total detection and apprehension or deflection

- 1 of illegal aliens attempting to cross the border into this state;
- 2 <u>and</u>
- 3 (2) otherwise enforcing federal immigration laws,
- 4 including detecting, apprehending, detaining, prosecuting,
- 5 releasing, and monitoring of illegal aliens.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
