7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

8 SECTION 1. Section 312.005(a), Tax Code, is amended to read

9 as follows:

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- 10 (a) The comptroller shall maintain a central registry of
- 11 reinvestment zones designated under this chapter and of ad valorem

12 tax abatement agreements executed under this chapter. The chief

13 appraiser of each appraisal district that appraises property for a

taxing unit that has designated a reinvestment zone or executed a

15 tax abatement agreement under this chapter shall deliver to the

16 comptroller before July 1 of the year following the year in which

17 the zone is designated or the agreement is executed a report

18 providing the following information:

19 (1) for a reinvestment zone, a general description of

20 the zone, including its size, the types of property located in it,

21 its duration, and the guidelines and criteria established for the

22 reinvestment zone under Section 312.002, including subsequent

23 amendments and modifications of the guidelines or criteria;

24 (2) a copy of each tax abatement agreement to which a

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- 1 taxing unit that participates in the appraisal district is a party;
- 2 [and]
- 3 (3) the information described by Section
- 4 312.205(a)(1) in connection with each tax abatement agreement
- 5 described by Subdivision (2) of this subsection; and
- $\underline{(4)}$ any other information required by the comptroller
- 7 to administer this section [and Subchapter F, Chapter 111].
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
