A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT relating to the exclusive jurisdiction of the state to regulate 2 3 greenhouse gas emissions in this state and the express preemption 4 of local regulation of those emissions. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 382, Health and Safety 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 382.005 to read as follows: 7 8 Sec. 382.005. EXCLUSIVE JURISDICTION ТО REGULATE GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS AND EXPRESS PREEMPTION OF 9 LOCAL REGULATIONS. (a) In this section, "greenhouse gas emissions" has 10 the meaning assigned by Section 382.05102. 11 12 (b) To the extent not preempted by federal law, the state 13 has exclusive jurisdiction over the regulation of greenhouse gas 14 emissions in this state. 15 (c) A municipality or other political subdivision may not enact or enforce an ordinance or other measure that directly 16 17 regulates greenhouse gas emissions. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 21 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
