- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 37.056(d), Utilities Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (d) The commission by rule shall establish criteria, in
- 8 addition to the criteria described by Subsection (c), for granting
- 9 a certificate for a transmission project that serves the ERCOT
- 10 power region, that is not necessary to meet state or federal
- 11 reliability standards, and that <u>is not included in a plan developed</u>
- 12 under Section 39.904(g) [does not serve a competitive renewable
- 13 energy zone]. The criteria must include a comparison of the
- 14 estimated cost of the transmission project for consumers and the
- 15 estimated cost savings for consumers that may result from the
- 16 transmission project. The commission shall include with its
- 17 decision on an application for a certificate to which this
- 18 subsection applies findings on the criteria.
- 19 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 20 a proceeding affecting a certificate of public convenience and
- 21 necessity that commences on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 22 A proceeding affecting a certificate of public convenience and
- 23 necessity that commenced before the effective date of this Act is
- 24 governed by the law in effect on the date the proceeding is

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- 1 commenced, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
