16	operating under Subtitle K, Title 6, if the motor bus is:
17	(A) operating within the boundaries of a
18	metropolitan planning organization in which:
19	(i) at least five counties are located; and
20	(ii) the two counties with the largest
21	populations are part of a regional mobility authority governed by
22	Chapter 370; and
23	(B) bypassing traffic on a highway that is under
24	construction by operating on a shoulder designated by the Texas
