- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 12A.004(a), Education Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A local innovation plan may not provide for the 8 exemption of a district designated as a district of innovation from
- 9 the following provisions of this title:
- 10 (1) a state or federal requirement applicable to an 11 open-enrollment charter school operating under Subchapter D,
- 12 Chapter 12;

- 13 (2) Subchapters A, C, D, and E, Chapter 11, except that
- 14 a district may be exempt from Sections 11.1511(b)(5) and (14) and
- 15 Section 11.162;
- 16 (3) educator certification requirements under Chapter
- 17 21 for teachers assigned to teach subject areas included in the
- 18 <u>foundation curriculum under Section 28.002(a)(1);</u>
- 19 <u>(4)</u> state curriculum and graduation requirements
- 20 adopted under Chapter 28; and
- 21 (5) (4) academic and financial accountability and
- 22 sanctions under Chapters 39 and 39A.
- SECTION 2. Section 12A.004(a), Education Code, as amended
- 24 by this Act, applies to each local innovation plan adopted under

S.B. No. 1320

- 1 Chapter 12A, Education Code, regardless of whether the plan was
- 2 adopted before, on, or after the effective date of this Act. A local
- 3 innovation plan adopted or renewed before the effective date of
- 4 this Act must comply with Section 12A.004(a), Education Code, as
- 5 amended by this Act, not later than September 1, 2023.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
