- 1 associate or baccalaureate degree;
- 2 (C) includes opportunities for students to earn
- 3 college credit for coursework; and
- 4 (D) includes, as an integral part of the program,
- 5 participation by students and teachers in activities of career and
- 6 technical student organizations supported by the agency and the
- 7 State Board of Education; [and]
- 8 (4) a school district provides, to the greatest extent
- 9 possible, to a student participating in a career and technology
- 10 education program opportunities to enroll in dual credit courses
- 11 designed to lead to a degree, license, or certification as part of
- 12 the program; and
- 13 (5) school districts and postsecondary educational
- 14 institutions have access to labor market information generated by
- 15 state agencies and guidance on the use of that information in
- 16 <u>designing career and technology education courses</u>.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
