## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the investigation of municipal fire fighters.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 614, Government Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 614.024 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 614.024. INVESTIGATION OF MUNICIPAL FIRE FIGHTERS
7	REQUIRED. (a) In this section:
8	(1) "Fire fighter" means a paid employee of a
9	municipal fire department.
10	(2) "Investigation" means an administrative
11	investigation conducted by a municipality of alleged misconduct by
12	a fire fighter that could result in punitive action against the fire
13	<u>fighter.</u>
14	(3) "Punitive action" means a disciplinary
15	suspension, indefinite suspension, demotion in rank, reprimand, or
16	any combination of those actions.
17	(b) Notwithstanding Section 614.021(b), this section
18	applies to a fire fighter employed by a municipality regardless of
19	whether the municipality is covered by a meet and confer or
20	collective bargaining agreement under Chapter 143 or 174, Local
21	Government Code.
22	(c) In addition to the requirements of Section 614.023, a
23	municipality may not take punitive action against a fire fighter

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unless an investigation has been conducted in accordance with

- 1 Section 143.123 or 143.312, Local Government Code, or other
- 2 <u>applicable law.</u>
- 3 (d) A municipality to which Section 143.123 or 143.312,
- 4 Local Government Code, or another substantially similar
- 5 investigation requirement does not apply shall adopt and comply
- 6 with procedures substantially identical to those required by
- 7 Section 143.312, Local Government Code.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 614.023(a), Government Code, is amended
- 9 to read as follows:
- 10 (a) A copy of a signed complaint against a law enforcement
- 11 officer of this state or a fire fighter, detention officer, county
- 12 jailer, or peace officer appointed or employed by a political
- 13 subdivision of this state shall be given to the officer or employee:
- 14 (1) within a reasonable time after the complaint is
- 15 filed; or
- (2) for a municipal fire fighter, in accordance with
- 17 procedures adopted under Section 614.024(d).
- SECTION 3. Section 614.024, Government Code, as added by
- 19 this Act, applies only to an investigation, as that term is defined
- 20 by that section, initiated by a municipality on or after the
- 21 effective date of this Act.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
