               (1) a standard health benefit plan issued under
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   Chapter 1507;
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               (2) a basic coverage plan under Chapter 1551;
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               (3) a basic plan under Chapter 1575;
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               (4) a primary care coverage plan under Chapter 1579;
               (5) a plan providing basic coverage under Chapter

- 6 therapy services must provide coverage for speech therapy services
- 7 provided through a telehealth service in the same manner as

- 9 (d) A health benefit plan must reimburse a preferred or
- 10 contracted health professional for providing speech therapy
- 11 services to a covered patient as a telehealth service on the same
- 12 basis and at least at the same rate that the issuer provides
- 13 reimbursement to that health professional for speech therapy
- 14 services in an in-person setting.
- SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to a health benefit plan that is delivered, issued for delivery, or
- 17 renewed on or after January 1, 2022. A health benefit plan that is
- 18 delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2022,
- 19 is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the
- 20 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 21 that purpose.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
