- SECTION 1. Section 111.003(a), Local Government Code, 5 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Not later than August 15 [During the 7th or the 10th
- 8 month of the fiscal year, as determined by the commissioners
- court], the county judge, assisted by the county auditor or county 9
- 10 clerk, shall prepare a budget to cover all proposed expenditures of
- the county government for the succeeding fiscal year. 11
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 111.006(a), Local Government Code, is
- amended to read as follows: 13

- 14 (a) Not later than August 15 [When the county judge has
- 15 completed the preparation of the budget], the county judge shall
- file a copy of the proposed budget with the county clerk. 16
- SECTION 3. Sections 111.007(b) and (c), Local Government 17
- Code, are amended to read as follows: 18
- 19 The commissioners court shall hold [set] the hearing not
- later than the 25th [for a date after the 15th] day after [of the 20
- 21 month next following] the day [month in which] the budget is filed
- 22 under [was prepared in accordance with] Section 111.006 [111.003,

- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
