S.B. No. 1371

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the reporting of certain incidents of sexual 3 harassment, sexual assault, dating violence, or stalking at certain 4 public or private institutions of higher education.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 51.252, Education Code, is amended by 7 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c-1) to read as 8 follows:

9 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c) <u>or (c-1)</u>, the 10 report must include all information concerning the incident known 11 to the reporting person that is relevant to the investigation and, 12 if applicable, redress of the incident, including whether an 13 alleged victim has expressed a desire for confidentiality in 14 reporting the incident.

(c-1) A campus peace officer employed by a postsecondary 15 educational institution who receives information regarding an 16 incident described by Subsection (a) from an alleged victim who 17 chooses to make a report to the officer using the pseudonym form 18 described by Article 58.102, Code of Criminal Procedure, shall, in 19 making a report under this section, state only the type of incident 20 reported and may not include the victim's name, phone number, 21 address, or other information that may directly or indirectly 22 23 reveal the victim's identity.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
