9	(b) For purposes of this section, the effective date of a
10	trust is the date the trust becomes irrevocable.
11	(c) An interest in a trust must vest, if at all:
12	(1) not later than 300 years after the effective date
13	of the trust, if the effective date of the trust is on or after
14	September 1, 2021; or
15	(2) except as provided by Subsection (d),
16	[Accordingly, an interest is not good unless it must vest, if at
17	all,] not later than 21 years after some life in being at the time of
18	the creation of the interest, plus a period of gestation, if the
19	effective date of the trust is before September 1, 2021.
20	(d) An interest in a trust that has an effective date before
21	September 1, 2021, may vest as described by Subsection (c)(1) if the
22	trust instrument provides that an interest in the trust vests under
23	the provisions of this section applicable to trusts on the date that
24	the interest vests.
