- 16 imposed under Chapter 118, Local Government Code, Chapter 51,
- 17 Government Code, or other law, unless the county first determines
- 18 that [+
- 19 [(1) the costs relate to services provided or to be
- 20 provided in a private mental hospital; or
- [(2)] the person charged with the costs is a person or
- 22 estate liable for the patient's support in a department mental
- 23 health facility.

- 2 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 3 a cost incurred on or after the effective date of this Act. A cost
- incurred before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- 5 laws in effect at that time, and the former law is continued in
- 6 effect for that purpose.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
