6	SECTION 3. Section 773.119(b), Health and Safety Code, is
7	amended as follows:
8	(b) The executive commissioner by rule shall establish
9	eligibility criteria for awarding the grants. The rules must
10	require the department to consider:
11	(1) the need of an area for the provision of emergency
12	medical services or trauma care and the extent to which the grant
13	would meet the identified need;

- 15 programs;
- (3) the availability of other funding sources; 16
- (4) the assurance of providing quality services; 17
- 18 (5) the use or acquisition of helicopters for emergency
- medical evacuation; [and] 19
- 20 (6) the development or existence of an emergency
- medical services system; and 21
- 22 (7) the development of a centralized system for the
- dispatch, triage, transport, and transfer of patients, including 23
- the use or acquisition of technology, to ensure coordinated patient 24

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- 1 transports and transfers, the efficient utilization of trauma care
- 2 <u>and emergency medical services.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a
- 4 vote of two-thirds of all members elected to each house, as provided
- 5 by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not
- 6 receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes
- 7 effect September 1, 2021.
