1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to required written consent of a physician, intern, or
1-22 resident of an educational institution before directly or
1-23 indirectly performing or participating in an elective abortion.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Chapter 103, Occupations Code, is amended by
1-26 adding Section 103.0015 to read as follows:

1-27 Sec. 103.0015. OPT IN REQUIRED. A physician, intern, or
1-28 resident of an educational institution may not be scheduled for or
1-29 assigned to duties involving directly or indirectly performing or
1-30 participating in an elective abortion procedure unless the
1-31 physician, intern, or resident first affirmatively consents in
1-32 writing to performing or participating in the procedure.

1-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
