A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to withdrawals of water from the Edwards Aquifer to supply 3 a military installation. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 1.33, Chapter 626, Acts of the 73rd Legislature, Regular Session, 1993, is amended to read as 6 follows: 7 Sec. 1.33. WELL METERING 8 AND PERMITTING EXEMPTIONS [EXEMPTION]. 9 SECTION 2. Section 1.33, Chapter 626, Acts of the 73rd 10 11 Legislature, Regular Session, 1993, is amended by adding 12 Subsections (e), (f), and (g) to read as follows: 13 (e) In addition to permitted withdrawals from the aquifer, a 14 municipally owned utility owned by the City of San Antonio, without a permit, may withdraw groundwater from the aquifer if: 15 16 (1) the utility uses the groundwater to supply a military installation with water for human consumption, 17 irrigation, operations, mission support, or infrastructure 18 19 maintenance; (2) the utility and the military installation enter 20 21 into a contract requiring the installation to reduce its groundwater withdrawals from the aquifer by the same amount of 22 23 withdrawn water the installation receives from the utility; and (3) the utility complies with rules adopted by the 24

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authority that allow the authority to monitor groundwater 1 withdrawals from the aquifer by the utility and determine amounts 2 of groundwater exempted from permitting in accordance with this 3 subsection, including rules requiring the reporting of amounts 4 5 supplied by the utility to the military installation and amounts by 6 which the military installation reduces the installation's 7 groundwater withdrawals from the aquifer. (f) Subsection (e) of this section does not alter the 8 obligations of a military installation under a biological opinion 9 10 issued by a federal agency. (g) The amount of water provided by a municipally owned 11 12 utility to a military installation under Subsection (e) of this section may not exceed the maximum amount of water that the military 13 installation is authorized to withdraw from the aquifer under a 14 15 biological opinion issued by a federal agency. 16 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
