## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

2 relating to the issuance of Texas Mobility Fund obligations.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 201.943(a), Transportation Code, is 5 amended to read as follows:

Subject to Subsections (e), (f), and (g), [and (1),] the 6 (a) commission by order or resolution may issue obligations in the name 7 8 and on behalf of the state and the department and may enter into credit agreements related to the obligations. The obligations may 9 be issued in multiple series and issues from time to time in an 10 aggregate amount not exceeding the maximum obligation amount. The 11 12 obligations may be issued on and may have the terms and provisions 13 the commission determines appropriate and in the interests of the state. The obligations may be issued as long-term obligations, 14 short-term obligations, or both. The latest scheduled maturity of 15 an issue or series of obligations may not exceed 30 years. 16

SECTION 2. Section 201.943(1), Transportation Code, is repealed.

19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
