5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Chapter79,Government Code, is amended by
7	addingSection79.044to read as follows:
8	(a) Thissection applies only to a county with a population
9	of more than 3.3 million.
10	(b) The number of court appointments in criminal cases
11	received by an attorney is not to exceed theguidelines contained in
12	caseload studies published by the commissionpursuant to House Bill
13	1318, 83 <sup>rd</sup> Texas Legislature.
14	(c) If information provided under Section 79.036(a-1) shows
15	that the number of appointments made to an attorney accepting
16	appointments in the county exceeds caseload guidelines, the county
17	may withhold payment to that attorney for those cases that
18	exceed the caseload guidelines.
19	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
