- 9 SECTION 2. The heading to Subchapter Q, Chapter 411,
- 10 Government Code, as added by Chapter 227 (H.B. 1769), Acts of the
- 11 86th Legislature, Regular Session, 2019, is amended to read as

- 13 SUBCHAPTER Q. COORDINATED LAW ENFORCEMENT ADULT RESCUE (CLEAR)

- SECTION 3. Section 411.461(2), Government Code, as added by
- 16 Chapter 227 (H.B. 1769), Acts of the 86th Legislature, Regular
- 17 Session, 2019, is amended to read as follows:

- 19 Enforcement Adult Rescue (CLEAR) alert for missing adults that is

- 1 (CLEAR) ALERT FOR MISSING ADULTS.
- 2 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
