## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the establishment of the election integrity division in
- 3 the office of the attorney general.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 273, Election Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 273.0025 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 273.0025. REQUEST FOR RECORDS. (a) An election
- 8 official or political subdivision shall promptly provide access to
- 9 <u>election records requested by a law enforcement officer or</u>
- 10 prosecutor in connection with an investigation under this
- 11 subchapter.
- 12 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this code,
- 13 copies of records and information provided pursuant to Subsection
- 14 (a) or another section of this code shall be provided in an
- 15 unredacted format and shall, upon request, be certified by the
- 16 official providing the records.
- 17 (c) A request made under this section is not a public
- 18 information request under Chapter 552, Government Code, and the
- 19 records and information provided under this section are
- 20 confidential. The original election records in the custody of an
- 21 election official or political subdivision remain subject to
- 22 existing law, but must be retained pending the final outcome of any
- 23 investigation and resulting litigation, including appeal.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 402, Government Code, is

- 1 amended by adding Section 402.0385 to read as follows:
- 2 Sec. 402.0385. ELECTION INTEGRITY DIVISION. (a) The
- 3 office of the attorney general shall establish an election
- 4 integrity division to safeguard the integrity of elections, ensure
- 5 public confidence in the electoral process, and investigate and
- 6 prosecute election fraud offenses under the laws of this state.
- 7 (b) The election integrity division shall, using available
- 8 funds or any funds appropriated to the division, investigate and
- 9 prosecute, when appropriate, credible complaints of election fraud
- 10 pursuant to authority granted under Chapter 273, Election Code.
- 11 (c) A law enforcement agency in this state shall assist the
- 12 election integrity division in an investigation conducted under
- 13 this section as requested by the division.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
