3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Sections 276.013(a) and (b), Election Code, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	Sec. 276.013. ELECTION FRAUD. (a) A person commits an
7	offense if the person knowingly or intentionally makes any effort
8	to:
9	(1) influence the independent exercise of the vote of
10	another in the presence of the ballot or during the voting process;
11	(2) cause a voter to become registered, a ballot to be
12	obtained, or a vote to be cast under false pretenses; [ <del>or</del> ]
13	(3) count invalid votes or alter a report to include
14	invalid votes;
15	(4) fail to count valid votes or alter a report to
16	exclude valid votes; or
17	[ <del>(3)</del> ] <u>(5)</u> cause any intentionally misleading
18	statement, representation, or information to be provided:
19	(A) to an election official; or
20	(B) on an application for ballot by mail, carrier
21	envelope, or any other official election-related form or document.
22	(b) An offense under this section is a [ <del>Class A misdemeanor</del> ]
23	felony of the second degree.
24	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
