- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 48.005(d), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (d) The commissioner may adjust the average daily
- 8 attendance of a school district in which a disaster, flood, extreme
- 9 weather condition, fuel curtailment, or other calamity has a
- 10 significant effect on the district's attendance. <u>In addition to</u>
- 11 providing the adjustment for the amount of instructional days
- 12 during the semester in which the calamity first occurred, an
- 13 adjustment under this section may only be provided based on a
- 14 particular calamity for an additional amount of instructional days
- 15 equivalent to one school year. The commissioner may divide the
- 16 <u>adjustment between two consecutive school years.</u>
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
